The Action Center's annual Holiday Gift Shop help provide holiday magic to over 3,800 children, from birth to age 12, with gifts. Items are limited and based on the size of the family and age of the child. This event is open to Jefferson County residents, be a participant of The Action Center or those experiencing homelessness.

On your designated pick-up day, you **MUST BRING WITH YOU**: Your Photo ID, Proof of Address and **one** of the following documents for each child to show their age: copy of their birth certificate, medical record with birthday, school record/report card that shows the grade they're enrolled in this year, (you can use parent portal on your phone) or blue/purple birth certificate issued by The Action Center.

Absolutely NO children are allowed at the Holiday Gift Shop. If you have no other choice, an adult must stay with them in the lobby while you shop, no exceptions.

Come to the Holiday Gift Shop ONLY on the day that matches your Last Name.

If you come before your assigned day, you will be asked to return on an Open Day

DSCS works with local social service, welfare, charitable, religious, housing organizations, etc., inviting their clients to the Shop to choose toys for their children. Denver Human Services (DHS) clients on SNAP, TANF, Medicaid or SSI – with children 11 years and younger – are eligible for admittance to DSCS.

To qualify, non-DHS client families, be Denver County residents, be registered with & referred to DSCS by social service agencies such as Catholic Charities, Denver Public Schools' Homeless Education Network, Colorado Coalition for the Homeless, Head Start, or Volunteers of America.

For admittance to the Shop, you must bring a Photo ID, proof of Denver residency, children's birth certificates or Medicaid cards and your "1B" DHS case number if applicable.

The Santa Shop requests that individuals attend the event on specific days according to the Caretaker's last name. *Please not that the Santa Shop is restocked with gifts at the end of each day*
